MN Family Investment Program (MFIP)

- Average of 27,000 families per month receiving benefits each month
- About 6600 cases are child only cases
- The average monthly grant is \$863 (\$397 cash & \$400 SNAP benefits)

MFIP-SNAP for Minnesota Families

MN combines the cash benefits with SNAP benefits

Why combine cash and SNAP? What are the benefits?

- 1. Further the MFIP mission: Support and Reduce Poverty
- 2. Financial management simplification for the families
- 3. Support the states goal to not have increases in cash benefits offset by cuts to food benefits
- 4. Supports work and reduces poverty
- 5. Families keep more cash in the home when they go to work

Optional Caregivers

Who is eligible for relative caregiver cases?

Any of the adults who live with the child and give the child care and support can be optional caregivers

- Grandparents
- Siblings
- Uncles and Aunts
- First Cousins and First Cousins once removed
- Legal custodian or legal guardian
- A spouse or former spouse of any of the above even after the marriage ends by death of divorce
