

The DC Child and Family Services Agency administers a robust Kinship Support Program that engages relative caregivers of children residing in Washington, D.C. with the intention of improving community and caregiver capacity to keepchildren safe and well in the homes of their relatives, the Kinship Navigator Program will enhance the existing services and supports that the Kinship Support Program offers.

- Kinship Caregiver Warm Line: This service line is used to provide referrals and linkages for caregivers to community-based resources that are equipped to address a variety of requests. The support line is available Monday through Friday from 8:15am to 4:45pm at (866)FAM-KIN1 or (866)326-5461.
- **Web-based Community Resource Directory**: Kinship Navigator staff provide robust resources for relative caregivers inside and outside the foster care system, providing referrals and linkage to community services and supports. We are striving to improve community and caregiver capacity to keep children safe and well in the homes of their relatives.

Grandparent Caregiver Program (GCP)

The Grandparent Caregiver Program helps low-income District residents who are raising their grandchildren, great-grandchildren, great-nieces, or great-nephews. Close Relative Caregiver Program (CRCP)
