Goal of the Extended Family Support Program (EFSP)

To assist the relative caregiver provide a stable home where they can care for their relative's child.



Target Population



- Relative or Fictive Kin
- Live together for more than 14 days
- Relative caregiver seeks the services
- Not part of a DCFS case
- Parent not in the home


General Tips for Caregivers Calling the Hotline

- Relative caregiver calls our hotline
- State "I am caring for my relative's children. They are not being abused nor neglected but I need help."
- Ask for "EFSP"
- Provide additional information



Guardianship

- Most seek it
- Primary goal of EFSP
- Empowers caregiver
- Protects children



Legal Rights Prior to Obtaining Guardianship

- Caregivers have very limited rights
- Difficulty obtaining some services
- Parents can seek custody



EFSP Services

- Short term intervention
- Guardianship advocacy
- Entitlements advocacy
- Enroll children in school
- Referrals for needed services
- Cash assistance



EFSP Success

- We reviewed children served in SFY17. More than 4 years later:
- 1.7% placed in care
- 9.4% part of intact case.
- 84% of those intact cases had a different caregiver



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
